


State Center 5-Year Graduate Growth Continues; Statewide Trends Drop in Associates Degrees





State Center Continues Upward Trend in Certificate Awards, Statewide Trends Drop Over Past Year




State Center Outpaces the State by Reducing the Number of Units for Students to Complete






Three Years of Earned Associates Degrees and Certificates








Madera Average Units for AS Degrees

+7% increase in average number of units accumulated by first-time associate degree earners over 3 years






Increase in Student Transfers to Four-year Institutions Compared to Previous Year







6% decrease in average number of units accumulated by first-time associate degree earners over 5 years



Increase in Student Transfers to Four-year Institutions Over 5 Years












Program Awards Increased Over 5 Years





Average Units to First AS Degree Decreased






Decrease in Student Transfers to Four-year Institutions Over 5 Years

BARRIERS


- Completion metrics are lagging indicators:

- Inquiry, including focus groups in the spring of 2024 to better understand how we can best support transfer.









Certificate Awards Completed Increased Over 5 Years

-10/o Completers compared to last year








Decrease in Reedley Average Units for AS Degrees

6% decrease in the average number of units accumulated by first-time associate degree earners over 5 years



Completion Definitions & Data Sources




Completion includes achieving one or more of the following: earned a certificate, associate degree, or transferred to a 4-year institution.

All Students: had an enrollment as a non-special admit student in at least one term of a selected year.

Transfer Students: Students who earned 12+ units at any college up to and including the selected year, who exited the community college system and enrolled in any 4-year institution in the subsequent year.

Former **CTE Students**, who after leaving community college did not transfer to another institution, self-report in a systemwide annual CTE Outcomes Survey whether they are employed in a job very closely or closely related to their field of study.
